COURT USAGE SCHEDULE DURING CLUB HOURS

- Club hours are defined as Monday through Saturday, 7:30 am to 10:30 am.

Monday through Saturday:

- Beginner (1.0 - 2.5) players on Upper Courts 1, 2, 3, 5 & 6 for **recreational** play. The queue line would start at the east gate and continue south (toward the Hobby Building parking lot) on the sidewalk.
- Upper Court #4 is designated as a Challenge Court.
 - A pair of players challenge the winners of the current game.
 - The winning team stays on the court and **remains a team**.
 - The next in line to challenge replaces the losing team.
 - The Challenge Court Wait Line will be at the west gate of the Upper Courts.
 - If the Challenge Court is not being used, 1.0 > 2.5 players may play on Court #4 until at least 4 Challenge players request to Challenge each other.
- Intermediate (3.0) players on the Lower Courts 7 - 12 for **recreational** play. The queue line would start at the west gate of the Lower Courts and continue on the sidewalk toward the new parking lot.
- Advanced (3.5) players on the Back Courts 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, & 23 for **competitive** play. The queue line would start at the east gate of the Back Courts.
- Back Courts 17 & 18 are designated for 4.0 players. The queue line would start at the north gate of the Back Courts.

For reference, the Upper Courts are courts 1 – 6 and are right next to the Recreation Center building. The Lower Courts are courts 7 – 12 directly to the west of the Upper Courts and down the steps. The Back Courts are the 8-court pod numbered 16 – 23 across the small parking lot and to the west of the Lower Courts.

The Side Courts are the 3-court pod directly to the south of the Upper Courts and are numbered 13, 14, & 15. These courts are NOT to be used by Club members during Club hours (7:30 am – 10:30 am). They are designated for non-Club member resident's use only. After Club hours anyone can play on these courts.

Players are encouraged to play in any extra calendar events that might be available and play with a private group after Club hours to avoid overcrowding on the courts.

During Club hours all players must rotate, regardless of whether the courts are full or not. Private groups should not play on a court by themselves.

Players should not play with the same partner all the time. The winners of the game split to opposite sides of the court, the non-winners leave the court, and two new players come out to play with the winners. This does not pertain to the Challenge Court.
